

## Longevity/Site Fidelity for Birds Retrapped in 2005

Noteworthy records –

- Willow Warbler (1Y 3825) ringed as a juvenile on 18<sup>th</sup> July 1998 was retrapped the following year and then not again until 11<sup>th</sup> June this year
- Blue Tit (K575577) was ringed as a juvenile on 26<sup>th</sup> September 1998
- Great Tit (K575547) was ringed as an adult male on 19th September 1998
- Jay (DA 56832) an adult ringed on 20<sup>th</sup> November 2003 was found dead at the Reservoir by a visiting birdwatcher 500 days later on 3<sup>rd</sup> April this year. This is our first recovery of this species.
- Chaffinches (K575527) & (K575533) were both ringed, as adult male and juvenile respectively, on 19<sup>th</sup> September 1998
