

Longevity/Site Fidelity for Birds Retrapped in 2006

This year we have had several examples of long lived birds (as well as showing site fidelity). Two Reed Warblers (N592465 & N592573) and a Yellowhammer (N592009) were all ringed by us as adult birds in 1999 (making them at least eight years old). A seven year old Willow Warbler (0M4759) was ringed as a juvenile in the same year.
