



## Longevity/Site Fidelity for Birds Retrapped in 2010

Noteworthy record-

- Whitethroat (R 650020) ringed 15<sup>th</sup> May 2004 as an adult female and retrapped this year on 18<sup>th</sup> July could well be a contender for the European longevity record for this species if it survives its migration to and from Africa and we are lucky enough to retrap it next year. The Stanford bird holding the current record (see 2009 Longevity Report) was not retrapped this year.
