

Longevity/Site Fidelity for Birds Retrapped in 2011

Noteworthy records-

- Chaffinch (P773671) ringed as adult female on 4th May 2002, not retrapped until 3rd May this year.
- Garden Warbler (R651061) ringed as juvenile on 31st July 2004 returned to Stanford as a breeding male and retrapped every year since with the exception of 2010.
- Garden Warbler (T179169) ringed as breeding female on 2nd July 2005 and retrapped every year from 2008
- Reed Warbler (R180906) ringed as adult breeding male on 5th July 2003 was also retrapped in 2006 and 2009.
- Reed Warbler (R180928) ringed as adult breeding male on 5th July 2003 was retrapped in 2009.
- Reed Warbler (R181101) ringed as adult breeding female on 26th July 2003 was retrapped in 2004 and 2009.
- Reed Warbler (R181419) ringed as adult breeding male on 16th August 2003 was retrapped in 2004, 2008 and 2009.
- Whitethroat (R650913) was ringed as adult breeding female on 24th July 2004 and retrapped on 21st April 2011. This bird is 95 days short of the GB & Ireland longevity record for this species (which we currently hold at Stanford) but is older by at least a year as this bird was ringed as an adult whereas the current record is of a bird ringed as a juvenile.
