

## Longevity/Site Fidelity for Birds Retrapped in 2014

## Noteworthy records-

- Garden Warbler (T179169) was ringed as an adult female on 2nd July 2005 and has been subsequently retrapped 12 times and during each year except 2006 & 2007. Most recently trapped on 26th July 2014 at 9 years and 24 days, the bird is 10 months shy of the national longevity record.
- Blue Tit (T684126) was ringed as a 3J on 10th June 2006 and since then has been an infrequent visitor (trapped 6 times) to Stanford. This is the oldest Blue Tit recorded at Stanford (7 years 8 months 10 days).
- Blackbird (CL87412) has only been caught 4 times since being ringed as a 3M on 22nd December 2005 (Dec '07, June '13 & July '14).
