

## STANFORD RINGING GROUP ~ RECOVERIES and CONTROLS for 2018

The symbols and conventions used are listed below:

Age when ringed: The figures do not represent years. Interpretation is as follows:

- 1 pullus (nestling or chick)
  - fraction denominator indicates total number of pullus ringed from those present
- 1J just fledged and found very close to nest
- 2 fully grown, year of hatching quite unknown
- 3 hatched during calendar year of ringing
- 3J hatched during calendar year of ringing, still partly or completely in juvenile body plumage
- 4 hatched before calendar year of ringing, but exact year unknown
- 5 hatched during previous calendar year
- 6 hatched before previous calendar year, but exact year unknown

Sex: M = male, F =female.
